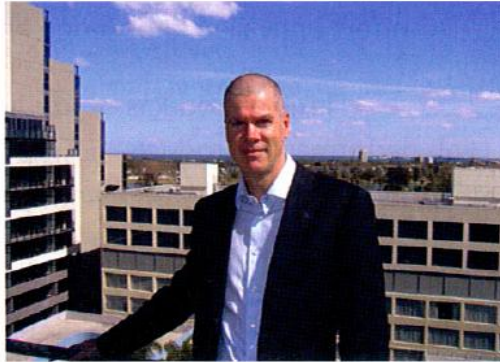




## Green IT awards goes to Raritan
